The bag isn't between the desks.

Is the bag between the desks? Yes, it is./ No, it isn't

7. What day is it today?

Today is the twentieth of March.

8. What day is your birthday this year?

It is on Saturday.

9. She is Australian and she's 16 years old.

She isn't Australian and she isn't 16 years old.

Is she is Australian and is she 16 years old. Yes, she is. /No, she isn't.

10. She speaks to her mother and father every day on her mobile phone.

She doesn't speak to her mother and father every day on her mobile phone.

Does she speak to her mother and father every day on her mobile phone?

Yes, she does. / No, she doesn't.

11. My sister's favourite thing is her bike.

My sister's favourite thing isn't her bike.

Is my sister's favourite thing her bike? Yes, it is./ No, it isn't

12. We're good at skateboarding.

We aren't good at skateboarding.

Are we good at skateboarding? Yes, we are. / No, we aren't.

13. My brother's best friend is Irish. He is from Ireland.

My brother's best friend isn't Irish. He isn't from Ireland.
